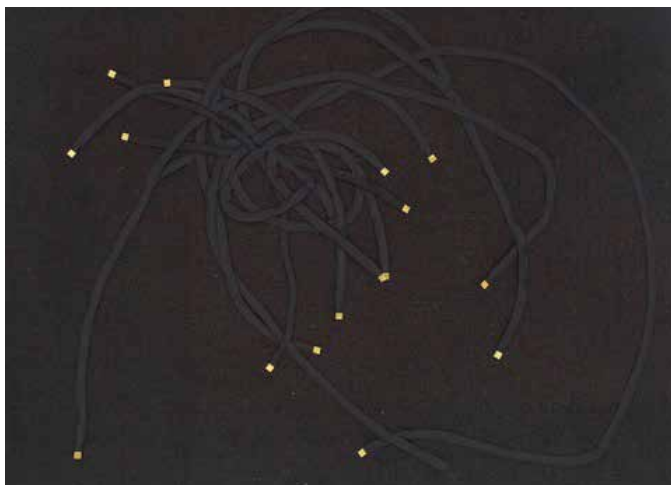

**Tiersa Nureyev Residency Exhibition**  
*The Lineal Project* (part one)

SFartsED Master Artist Tiersa Nureyev begins her Minnesota Street Project residency with the developing exhibition *Lineage* – an investigation of lines, connections, cultural history and heritage, interruption of family lines, red-lining in housing, processions, and the formal line as an initiator of two- and three-dimensional objects that can serve as environments for investigative performance and installation. Tiersa’s work will be developed through community workshops, pop-up shops, and a collaboration with fellow MSP artist-in-residence Laura Elaine Ellis in Spring, 2022.

Rehearsals embark in December with conservatory-style classes after school and on Saturdays. Guided by a creative team of professional directors, musicians, choreographers, and designers, the students hone their skills as triple-threat performers, culminating in a professional-level performance of a classic Broadway musical.
