AGELIO BATLE SIGNED “ASH DANCER” SKULL SCULPTURE (\$1,800)

Ash Dancer Skull (8” x 6”) was created by lauded Bay Area artist Agelio Batle as part of his 2016 installation at the **Jack Fisher Gallery**. For this exhibition, Batle sculpted a life-sized human skeleton out of solid graphite and rested it on paper atop a high-frequency vibrating table. A vivid metaphor for the ephemeral nature of life, the table’s relentless shaking resulted in eerily beautiful abstract compositions and the ultimate disintegration of the graphite bones (hence the need for reserve parts, such as this perfectly intact skull).
